Terms and Conditions Stichting Declarative Amsterdam

(Declarative Amsterdam Foundation)

1. Definitions

- a. Organization: The Declarative Amsterdam foundation
- b. Registration: Registration of a participant for a conference organized by the organization. An agreement is entered into between the organization and a participant.
- c. Conference: A conference organized by the organization.
- d. Participant: : Any natural or legal person who is registered as a participant of a conference organized by the organization.

2. Applicability

- a. These Terms and Conditions apply to all conferences organized by the organization.
- b. These Terms and Conditions are made available to the participants in advance via the website, https://declarative.amsterdam.
- c. By registering for a conference, the participant accepts the general terms and conditions.

3. Registration

- a. Registration takes place by means of submitting an online form and paying the conference fees in full.
- b. Registration can also take place by the organization itself, for instance for speakers or special guests.
- c. The organization confirms the registration in writing within a week.
- d. Free cancellation of registration is possible up to one week before the start of the conference. Any cancellations received within a week before or during the conference will not be refunded.

 The organization reserves the right to cancel registration and participation in the conference. This right will be used in exceptional cases only, for example in case of misconduct.

4. Conference

- a. The conference details (dates, schedule, venue, fees, etc.) will be announced on the organization's website.
- b. The organization will do its utmost to ensure that the congress proceeds as announced.
- c. The organization reserves the right to deviate from the announced conference program, for example in case of illness or unavailability of one of the speakers.
- d. The organization reserves the right to cancel the conference. In that case, any paid fees will be refunded.

5. Personal information

- a. The details of the participants are included in an administration set up for that purpose and are used for the announcement of next conferences.
- b. The organization will treat this information confidentially and will not make it available to third parties for advertising purposes or commercial activities.

6. Copyright and Intellectual property

a. Any applicable copyright and/or intellectual property right in connection with a conference is/remains the property of the organization and/or the guest speakers.

7. Liability

a. The organization is not liable for damage, from whatever cause, to goods or persons caused by or in connection with participating in a conference.

8. Applicable law
